4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

EYE CONTACT:	Remove from exposure. Wash immediately with copious quantities of water for at least 15 minutes and seek medical attention.
DERMAL CONTACT:	Remove from exposure. Wash immediately with copious quantities of water and, if irritation persists, seek medical attention.
INGESTION:	Never attempt to induct vomiting. Do not attempt to give any solid or liquid by mouth if the exposed subject is unconscious to semi-conscious. Wash out the mouth with water. If subject is fully conscious, give plenty of water to drink. Seek medical attention.
INHALATION:	Physical form suggests that the risk of inhalation exposure is negligible.
